RED PHASE (COUNTY ORDERS & CTCS MANDATED)- HIGH RISK, LARGE INCREASE IN CASES

REMOTE LEARNING ONLY

No athletic or extra-curricular events

GREEN PHASE

- On Campus operations as normal as possible
- All Students on campus for daily instruction
- ⇒ Normal Daily Schedule
- Some changes still necessary pending common spaces
- Minimal screening needed
- Athletics-per TAPPS
- Field Trips-very few, if any limitations □
- Metrics:
 - ◇ Low and lessening new cases in local area
 - ◇ Almost no new cases within school community
 - ◇ Situation is stable locally and regionally

YELLOW PHASE

- Maintain on-campus operations as normal as possible
- Parents/Guardians may choose Remote Learning on Face to Face Learning-Parents/guardians must sign Pandemic Policy Waiver
- All students on staggering schedule
- All faculty, staff, visitors, students screened prior to entering buildings to include temperature check
- Mask worn in designated areas 10 years or older
- Students and staff assigned to designated areas on campus
- Athletics-Level II or Level II per TAPPS Recommendations
- Metrics:
 - ◇ Significant increase in cases within the school and/or local community
 - ◇ Improvement in school and/or local community

ORANGE PHASE (county orders)

- Maintain on-campus operations as normal as possible
- Parents/Guardians may choose Remote Learning or Face to Face learning-must sign release waiver
- All students on staggering schedule
- Students and staff assigned to designated areas on camp
- Mask required for 10 years or older. Students shall wear a mask while in the hallways or other common areas where social distancing guidelines are not being met, while in work groups, and during discussions. Student shall have the option to lower their mask while seated at their desk/work station, while eating, or when outside and social distancing guidelines are being met
- No field trips, limited guests with permission to enter
- Athletics-Level II or Level III per TAPPS Recommendations
- Metrics:
 - ◇ High volume and/or continued increase in new cases within local area and community
 - ◇ County Judge mandates Public/Private schools to follow remote learning (CTCS will take Religious Freedom or Business Occupancy 50% rights)

RED PHASE (COUNTY ORDERS & CTCS ORDERS)- HIGH RISK, LARGE INCREASE IN CASES

- Central Texas School operates remotely for faculty, staff, and students. No athletics or extra-curricular activities.

REMOTE LEARNING OPTION

- Central Texas Christian School will be set up to accommodate students who desire Remote Learning even if on-campus learning is an option under Phase Yellow, Orange, or Red
- Students will log in at designated times for live and/or prerecorded instruction in all core subjects
- Families will have access to materials that can be printed from home or delivered or picked up from campus
- Secondary students will follow the same schedule as their regular class schedule
- Teachers will be available on Wednesday from 2:30-4:00 and Fridays from 12-4 to assist Remote Learning students
